Dr. Francisco “Cisco” Werner is Director of Scientific Programs and Chief Science Advisor of NOAA’s National Marine Fisheries Service (NMFS). He leads NMFS’ efforts to provide the science needed to support sustainable fisheries and ecosystems, ending overfishing, rebuilding fish populations, saving critical species, and preserving vital

habitats. Dr. Werner supervises the planning, development and management of a multidisciplinary scientific enterprise of basic and applied research, and he oversees NOAA’s Fisheries Science Service Centers and the Office of Science and Technology. Dr. Werner’s research has focused on the development of numerical models of ocean circulation, the effects of physical forcing on the structure and function of marine ecosystems, and he has contributed to the development and implementation of ocean forecasting systems.

Dr. Werner received his BSc in Mathematics and PhD in Oceanography, both from the University of Washington.
